Make sure you have a webcam installed on your computer or phone.


If you have issues connecting, please contact your internal IT or the main helpdesk at 512-475-9400.

UT Austin faculty and staff must use their Office 365 (@austin.utexas.edu) address to login. If it asks you for your password, it will be your EID password. You will need to use Duo Mobile too.
